2019 PARADE GUIDELINES

- There is NO rain date for the parade. If the weather is questionable, call the Chamber office on Monday after 8:00 am for announcement, or check the Chamber website (www.metuchenchamberexchange.com).
- The parade route is over one mile long. Walking participants should be able to keep up the marching pace for the entire parade route. Adults are welcome to accompany their children in the parade.
- Fire rules require that all floats are equipped with a fire extinguisher and have decorations that are not flammable. The Fire Marshall will test and remove any float that does not meet this standard.
- All marching units and participants are required to maintain a continuous forward motion during the parade. Please DO NOT STOP at the reviewing stand.
MARCHING PERFORMANCES ONLY!
- All marchers will follow instructions from the Parade Marshals.
- Distribution of candy, pamphlets or other materials along the parade route is strictly prohibited for the safety of the spectators and parade participants.
- All parade participants should report to a Parade Marshal in the parking lot for line of march information.
- Small vehicles will queue in the parking lot at the direction of Parade Marshals.
- Floats will queue in the parking lot at the direction of Parade Marshals.
- If for some reason a group is unable to participate in the parade, please notify the Chamber office no later than May 20, 2019.
- DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS FOR STAGING WILL BE SENT TO PARTICIPANTS UPON REGISTRATION, BUT PLAN TO BE IN PLACE AND READY TO MARCH **BEFORE** 9:30AM.
